- Have you ever had to handle/overcome a work-related crisis or problem?
- What do you like doing in your free time?
- Are you willing to relocate down the line?
- Did you ever have a favorite teacher or manager? Why were they your favorite?
- How do you like to be managed?
- Are you interviewing anywhere else?
- What was your reason for leaving your last job?
- How did you get along with your former boss/co-workers?
- Where do you see yourself in 5/10 years?
- What are some of your strengths?

- What are some of your weaknesses?
- Are you interested in promotional opportunities?
- How do you work with others?
- Would you consider yourself a leader or a follower?
- What are your salary expectations?
- Can you describe your ideal career path?
- What questions do you have for me?

INTERVIEW QUESTIONS YOU SHOULD ASK:

- Can you describe the daily tasks, duties, and responsibilities of the position?
- Who are the key people I would work with?
- Are there any unique opportunities/qualities with this job?
- What kind of training is offered? / What is training like?
- What are you looking for in a candidate?
- How will I be evaluated?
- Where do you see the company in the next 3, 5, 10 years?
- What kind of challenges does this role face?
- What are 3-4 qualities of your top 3 employees?
- Are there management/promotional opportunities available?
- What makes this company unique from its competition?
- Describe to me the culture within this organization—
